**200.19 Welcome** The Chair welcomed everybody.

**201.19 Conflict of Interests** None.

**202.19 Minutes of Previous Meeting** Were passed as a true record

**203.19 Treasurer's Report** JP issued the report to the meeting. The accounts are from April 2019 to date.

**204.19 Land Development** IM – The results of Housing Need Survey were received and circulated to the Board. The costs for this will come out of Copeland Borough Council's Community Housing grant. The company we used for the mail shot (Selectabase) sent the survey out to Distington addresses in error. They have since refunded us these costs. IM thanked all those who helped sorting surveys into newsletters. JP – we need to know the demand for affordable housing. IM - JP's comment was forwarded to Andy Lloyd and he will try and get that information from the survey.

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Craig Bradley of Homes England will be here on 4 September 2019 to chat with IM and SH.

**208.19 Walking Project** IM Initially after a good start, numbers for this project have dropped. We have changed the time from an evening to an afternoon walk but still have had no takers for the last 3 weeks. It has been widely publicised, and may have to fold if we don't get any takers. It is disheartening for volunteers who find time in their already busy schedules to lead the walks. Discussions were held about people's availability during school holidays, it was decided to look at the possibility of doing the walks on a monthly basis starting in September, some children have attended but the project is mainly aimed at reducing loneliness and promoting wellbeing so really the target group is adults. **ACTION: RR/JG to speak to KG and let office know**

**217.19 Any Other Business** A representative from Distington Surgery came to the latest Land Development meeting. It's good to get their expertise in what may be beneficial in a scheme for the over 55's. There is a possibility of building a treatment room in the new build as it would help them with their shortage of space, provide potentially new services and some revenue income for the scheme.

A thank you letter was received from Distington Community Centre for the donation of £10,000 towards their centre refurbishment.

Sellafield want projects for their Community Outreach Day in October (for their new intake of graduates to take part in). The project has to be happen on a set day (6 October 2019), involve 6-8 Sellafield trainees and take place indoors. Following a discussion, nothing specific sprung to mind.
